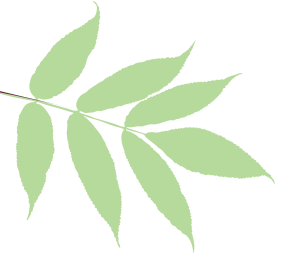


10th Annual Urban Ecology and Conservation Symposium
